

the same plan. Quite a number of the Baptist congregations have adopted it. It is meeting with extensive favor among the Episcopalians. The different churches in the United States are aiming at the same thing. A similar remark might be made in reference to the churches in Great Britain. The fact that our young men in the associations and conventions are directing their attention to it is a hopeful symptom. It shows that they have grasped the fundamental truth that giving from right motives is worship. It is prophetic of their success in securing the funds necessary to erect their buildings, to furnish their libraries and to carry on their benevolent work in every department. Let them master the principles of Scriptural Systematic Beneficence, let them reduce them to practice, let them labour with their wonted fervour and success to disseminate them among all the members of their associations, and throughout the several congregations with which they are connected and they will add another wreath to their laurels, and another triumph to the victories which they have won on the honourable field of Christian work and Christian achievement.
