

Gatted-Many Men Thrown Out of Work Brantford, March 4,--The Goold Shapley and Muir windmill and hes-supply building was badly gutted by fire early this morning. The loss will be in the neighborhood of \$20,000; insurance, \$19,000, as follows: Economical, \$22.03 Wellington Co, Mutual, \$1000; Witer, loo Co, Mutual, \$1500; Guardian, \$1000/ Hand-in-Hand, \$2500; Hartford, \$3300; Muliance, \$1000; London & Lancashire, Hand-in-Hand, \$2500; Hartford, \$5577, Alliance, \$1000; London & Lancesbire, \$1000; North British & Mercantile, \$5200. The fire is supposed to have originated from the friction of a belt. The Goold, Shapley and Muir people were very busy, and 175 men are out of work. The big Goold bicycle factory, adiaping fortunately escaped.
