

MINES AND MINING STOCKS.

Transactions Yesterday.

There was little activity on the Mining Exchange yesterday in the Toronto market. The only change in the morning Waterloo sold at 104, Old Ironides at 110, Rathmullen at 8, Rambler Cariboo at 22 1/2, Big Three at 20 1/2, Iron Mask at 7 1/2, War Eagle at 32 1/2, Van Andra at 10, in the afternoon Old Ironides sold at 110, Morrison at 16, Fern at 25, Payne at 10, Rambler Cariboo at 22, Van Andra at 10, War Eagle at 34 1/2, Princess Maud at 10, and Golden Star at 11 1/2.

Republic Camp.

Mr. Garty Parker writes: Perhaps the most important item of news received by me lately has reference to the Mountain Lion. The long-talked-of mill it is now definitely stated, will be in place early in January, 1900. Its capacity will be 100 tons, and the secretary, James H. W. West, is conducting the operations. The mill has placed an extensive order for lumber for the mill building. The mill is a combination one and will have 20 stamps.
