THE DISPENSARY INDISPENSABLE.

The city cannot now do without such an institution, or have its utility hampered or limited through lack of means to maintain and extend its undertakings. Besides the large number of poor visited by the physicians daily, there are sometimes as many as 35 patients for treatment at the rooms, and from 65 to 75 prescriptions to be delivered. The Board beg to express thanks to all who have assisted in keeping up the interest of the public in this noble charity, or who have contributed otherwise.
