

MONCTON DECLARES FOR USE OF CANADIAN PORTS

At Public Meeting Citizens Protest Against Possible Loss of Ocean Business and Proposed Transfer of Railway Offices to Upper Canada

Moncton, Feb. 28.—The relation of the Canadian National Railway system to the maritime provinces was the subject of a vigorous discussion at a largely attended meeting held in the Moncton city building tonight under the auspices of the board of trade, with J. A. Marven, president. Two strong resolutions were unanimously adopted. The sentiment of the meeting was emphatically against the transference of the C. G. R. executive and subordinate offices from the maritime provinces to central Canadian cities.




