

MUSTARD PICKLE. Three quarts of green tomatoes, on Three quarts of green tomatoes, one quart of onions, six green peppers, all cut up into small pieces. Sprinkle with one cup of salt, let stand over night or two or three hours in the morning. I fix all mine in the morning, then get out all the water, then add two medium-sized cauliflower (boiled tender in very little water), cut into small pieces, one pound of brown sugar, six tablespoons of mustard, one tablespoon of tumeric powder (not any more) three pints of vinegar; boil fifteen minutes. Then add one cup of sifted flour in one pint of vinegar (making two quarts in all). Boil until it thickens.
