Sec. 12. - When any death takes place in this Colony, information of the same shall be furnished or posted within 48 hours thereafter to the proper officer appointed ceive the same in the form pany's office, Carbonear. under this chapter to reof Schedule A, under a fine not exceeding Ten Dollars for every neglect to do so. The obligation to furnish this information shall rest, in the first instance, on the medical attendant; secondly, on the undertaker; and failing these, on the next of kin to the deceased per-

Sec. 14.—No sexton or other person having charge of a ceme tery or burial place shall permit the burial of any person in such cemetery or burial place without first having received a certificate signed by a MEDICAL ATTENDANT a CLERGYMAN, or TWO RELIABLE PERSONS cognizant of the facts certifying to the death of the person for whom burial is required, and setting forth as far as is known the cause of death: and all such certifi cates shall be forwarded monthly to the registering officers concerned.

This law does not apply to the City of Saint John's, where special and more strict regulations are en
