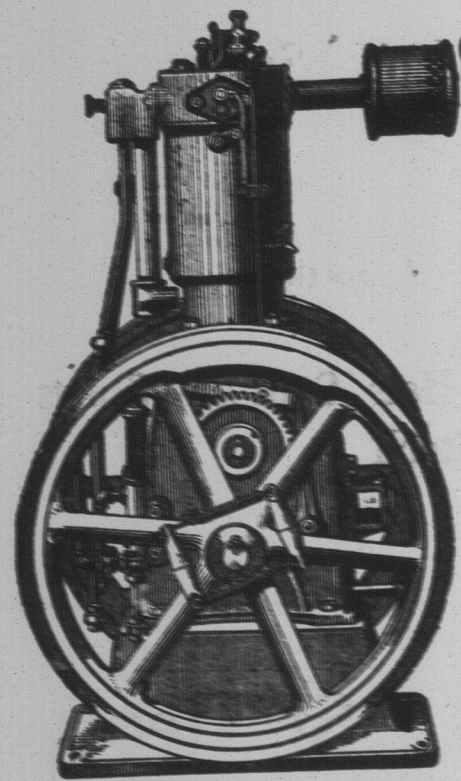

And yet there are here the man who is not afraid to let himself go, but who will stand up on his feet and speak with fire and force the thoughts that are in him, will sway the multitudes and for long years after influence the lives of men. Eloquence is not to be underrated in human affairs. Oratory, considering its influence, is quite too much neglected in our universities. —Toronto Star.
