Frederick, July 19.—The insurance on the Harley mill at Hourley Brook, on the Canada Eastern division of the I. C. R., has been adjusted by Edgar H. Fairweather, of St. John, who is here today. Insurance in several companies was carried on lumber to the amount of \$1,900, and on the mill to the amount of \$3,000. The loss was adjusted at \$5,000 on the lumber and \$2,400 on the mill. According to Mr. Fairweather, there is no doubt that the fire was of an incendiary nature, but there is also no doubt as to who are the guilty parties.
