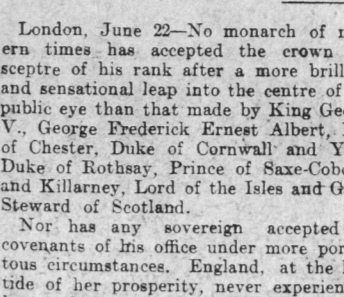

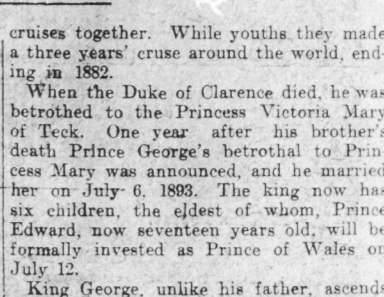
The English Royal Family

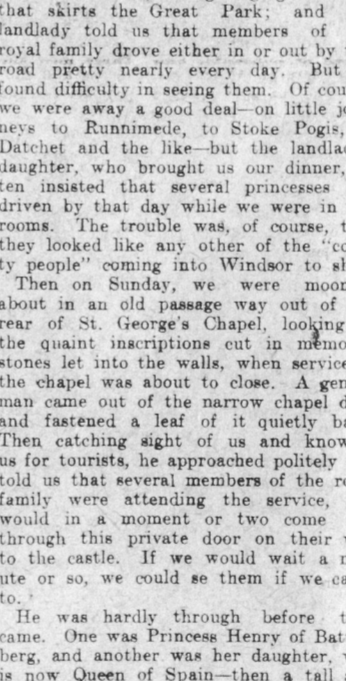
