

results are recorded in the Prefect of Studies' Register, and at the annual commencement, premiums are awarded in accordance therewith. In cases where the records disclose a parity of merit in the competitions of two or more students, the comparative excellence of their examination may decide the question of precedence.

A student who has secured exemption from a portion of a class programme forfeits, as a rule, his right to compete for honor awards or premiums of any kind.
