

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Allan J. MacEachen, is pleased to announce that the Honourable Jean Marchand, Minister without Portfolio, will head the Canadian delegation to the General Conference of the Agency for Cultural and Technical Cooperation to be held in Port-Louis (Mauritius) from November 12th to 15th, 1975.

Every two years, ministerial level delegations from all member countries meet in the General Conference, the governing body of the Agency for Cultural and Technical Cooperation. The last meeting was held in Liège and Brussels in October 1973.

The next General Conference will be preceded by a meeting of the Administrative Council of the Agency on November 9th and 10th, 1975 in Port-Louis. At the General Conference, the Canadian delegation, headed by Mr. Marchand, will participate in an examination of the general policy of the Agency for 1976 and 1977, as well as the budgets and programmes for these two years.
