The question of concurrence being put thereon, it was unanimously resolved in the affirmative.

Ordered, That the said Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General by such members of this House as are members of the Privy Council.

The Honourable Sir Oliver Mowat moved, seconded by the Honourable Mr. Scott, That pursuant to Rule 79, the following Senators be appointed a Committee of Selection, to nominate the Senators to serve on the several Standing Committees, namely:—The Honourable Messieurs Clemow, Sir Mackenzie Bowell, DeBoucherville, Lougheed, Miller, Macdonald (Victoria), Power, Scott, and the mover; and to report with all convenient speed the names of the Senators so nominated.

The question of concurrence being put thereon, the same was resolved in the affirm-

ative, and

Ordered, accordingly.

The Honourable Mr. McCallum presented to the Senate a Bill (A) intituled: "An Act to amend 'The Railway Act.'"

The said Bill was read a first time.

Ordered, That the said Bill be read a second time on Monday next.

The Honourable Mr. Aikins presented to the Senate a Bill (B) intituled: "An Act further to amend the law respecting Building Societies and Loan and Savings Companies carrying on business in the Province of Ontario."

The said Bill was read a first time.

Ordered, That the said Bill be read a second time on Tueday next.

Then, on motion of the Honourable Sir Oliver Mowat, seconded by the Honourable Mr. Scott,

The Senate adjourned.
