**BILL.**

**An Act to attach certain Lands in the Gore of Camden to the Township of Dawn.**

5 **W**HEREAS the inhabitants of the Lots from No. 19 to No. 24, both Preamble.  
 inclusive, in the Gore of Camden, now in the County of Kent,  
 and divers inhabitants of the Townships of Euphemia and Dawn in  
 the County of Lambton, have represented that the said Lots originally  
 10 formed part of Lots now in the Township of Dawn in the County of Lamb-  
 ton, and were detached from that Township through error as to their local  
 position; and that from the course and position of the River Sydenham at  
 that place, it is extremely inconvenient that the said Lots should be de-  
 tached from the said Township to which they naturally belong; and have  
 prayed that the said Lots may be again made to form part of the said Town-  
 15 ship of Dawn, and for the reasons aforesaid it is expedient to grant their  
 prayer: Be it therefore enacted, &c., as follows:

I. The said Lots, numbers nineteen, twenty, twenty-one, twenty-two, Certain lots in  
 twenty-three and twenty-four, in the Gore of Camden aforesaid, shall be the Gore of  
 detached from the Township of Camden and from the said County of Kent, Camden de-  
 20 and shall be annexed to and form part of the Township of Dawn and of the tached from  
 County of Lambton: but nothing herein contained shall affect the validity Township of  
 of any Election, Municipal or other, in which the inhabitants of the said Camden and  
 Lots may have taken part, or the payment or collection of any arrears of County of  
 assessments or taxes accrued before this Act shall come into force, but the Kent, and  
 25 same shall be paid and collected as if it had not been passed. annexed to

II. This Act shall come into force upon, from and after the first Monday Commence-  
 in January, 1855, and not before, and shall be deemed to be a Public Act. ment of this  
Act.
