

VI. And be it enacted, That except only
 2 in cases where it shall be otherwise provided
 by regulation of the Governor in Council,
 4 no entry shall be deemed perfect unless a
 sufficient invoice of the goods to be entered,
 6 attested as hereinafter required, shall have
 been produced to the collector; nor shall
 8 any goods be entered by bill of sight, not-
 withstanding any thing in the thirteenth
 10 Section or any other part of the Act hereby
 amended, unless in addition to the deposit of
 12 money required by the said Section, the
 person to whom such goods shall be deli-
 14 vered, shall take the oath in such case pro-
 vided in the Schedule to this Act, and shall
 16 jointly and severally with one or more
 sureties, give bond to the satisfaction of the
 18 collector, to produce a sufficient invoice of
 such goods attested in the manner required
 20 by this Act, and to make perfect entry
 thereof, and to pay any deficiency of duty
 22 thereon, within a time to be appointed by
 the collector, but this shall not exempt such
 24 person from compliance with all the require-
 ments of the said Act, nor prevent the sum
 26 of money by him deposited from being dealt
 with in the manner provided by the said
 28 Section, if perfect entry be not made within
 the time so appointed as aforesaid.

 the production
 of an invoice:
