An Act to enable the Trustees of Churches and Parsonages and other Trusts belonging to the Wesleyan Methodist Church in Canada, more conveniently to manage and dispose of their Estates.

WHEREAS by virtue of an Act of the Preamble.
 Parliament of the Province of Upper
 Canada, passed in the ninth year of the
 Reign of King George the Fourth, inti- Act U. C. 9
 5 tuled, "*An Act for the relief of the Reli-* Geo. 4, c. 2.
gious Societies therein mentioned," and of
 another Act of the Parliament of the
 said Province, passed in the third year of
 Her Majesty's Reign, Religious Congrega-
 10 tions or Societies of the Wesleyan Metho-
 dist Church in Canada, by Trustees, as au-
 thorized by the said Acts, have in several
 instances acquired certain lands, which, from
 circumstances, have become inappropriate
 15 for the purposes for which the same were
 obtained, and the said Trustees are unable
 either to exchange or otherwise to dispose
 of the same for the Trust purposes, and are
 also prevented from raising money, either by
 20 way of loan or of rental, on the Trust estate,
 notwithstanding it would in many instances,
 manifestly subserve the best interests of the
 said Trusts: And whereas it would be
 beneficial to the said Trusts to facilitate the
 25 management and disposal of the Trust pro-
 perty by the respective Trustees, subject
 however in all cases, to the consent of the
 Conference of said Church:—Be it there-
