Bathe your arms in the Sacred Lure of Bloody Passions

Santa Sangre
directed by Alejandro
Jodorowski
at the Paradise Cinema

Off the streets of Mexico City,
from the director of "El Topo,"
comes a new classic of its own
genre — *Santa Sangre*.

If you have ever been to the
circus, after seeing this film,
you may look at knife-throwing
and clowns in a totally different
light. From the passionate
embraces of a fully tattooed
woman to the welling pool of
blood coughed up by a dying
elephant, Jodorowski manages
to form an intense psychological
thriller.

The symbols of love, lust,
religion and death run rampant
throughout this film. From the
martyred image of an armless,
raped woman to the Egyptian
Phoenix, Jodorowski plays with
the viewer's mind on a very
deep, intellectual level.

This movie, although painful
to watch (because of the harsh
imagery and realistic under-
tones) is at worst slightly off-
ensive, at best, emotionally
compelling.

There are plenty of recogniz-
able image patterns, however,
the largest part of the energy is

beneath the surface, tapping
into the viewer's inner spaces.

If you want to see a film that
will entertain you, horrify you
and twist your mind, *Santa
Sangre* is the film for you. It's a
great bonus that we have a new
venue for alternative film. Take
advantage of it.
