I am very much disappointed in the home conditions on this reserves. Twenty-five years ago the conditions of the homes here was very good. Since that time, howeverm they have certainly gone back and now a great many of the Indians are living in shacks. Each year and now a great many of the Indians are living in shacks. Each year we take in a few hundred dollars from land that is leased to white men and I am of the opinion that some of this money should be used men and I am of the opinion that some of this money should be used each year to improve the home conditions there, but I shall report on this later because the water situation comes into question at the same time.
