



Dear Mr. Davis :-

In answer to your verbal inquiry about the land tendered for by Mr. W. E. Gladstone, I beg to say that on the 24th October, 1902, you wrote stating that Mr. Gladstone wished to get the land if it was still open for purchase, and, on the 4th November of the same year, you were informed that the Department was prepared to carry out the sale to him upon his paying the balance of the first payment, amounting to \$80.00. No payment, however, has since been made by him and nothing further has been done in the matter.
