I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the End instant enclosing rules and regulations with respect to the construction and maintenance of the roads together with a resolution of the Council adopting the same. I have also your letter of the 13th instant enclosing a letter from Mr. Indian Superintendent Logan of Parry Sound on behalf of Jonas King, a member of the Christian Island band, residing at Parry Island, and asking if Mr. King is liable for statute labour on Christian Island.

regulations the statute labour is to be performed in respect of membership and not in respect of land owned. It
appears to the Department that where statute labour is
performed in respect to membership it should only apply
to those members residing on the reserve and that members
who are residing permanently off the reserve, as in the
case of Mr. King, that they should not be called upon
for the performance of such statute labour. Before taking
any action with respect to these proposed regulations the
