Q-217 What were you referring to by that?

A-217 Referring to the open arrest he put me on on that obstacle

course. Q-218 You understood Sgt. McNab to speak to you individually, then, three times?

A-218. Yes, sir.

And, tell you to keep quiet? Q-219

Yes, sir. A-219

Q-220 And yet you continued to talk?

A-220 I kept quiet every time. The first time I didn't say anything to him, and the second time I didn't say anything to him.

But, you resumed talking? Q-221

After he left, sir. A-221

Q-222 Why did you resume talking?

A-222 I understood that as long as we were merching at ease, we

could speak. Q-223 You had been told that while you were marching at ease you could takk?

A-223 Yes, sir.

Had you ever been told you couldn't talk at ease because J-55# you were marbhing at night?

No, sir. A-PPH

Q-225 Did Sgt. McNab tell you that during this particular period in ouestion?

A-225 No, sir, he never explained it to me.

Why did you keep on talking? Q-226

He never explained it to me. A-226

Q-227 Even though he ordered you not to talk. Did you reslize you were disobeying a lawful order?

A-227 I didn't realize I was disobeying enything. I figured he had some grouch against me and he wanted me to keep quiet.
