in that he

when R.Q.M.S. of 8 Cdn Recce Bn (14H), in the field, between August, 1941 and 3 Feb 42, did wilfully obliterate a serial number from a Smith & Wesson pistol, .380 calibre, which pistol was public property.

THIRD CHARGE FRAUDULENTLY MISAPPLYING PUBLIC PROPERTY
A.Sec. 18(4)

in that he

on or about 18 Dec 41, in the field, when R.Q.M.S. of 8 Cdn Recce Bn (14H), did exchange a Smith & Wesson pistol .380 calibre, being public property, for Five Pounds (£5/0/0) with Sgt. Lacey of the same unit, the said Five Pounds being applied by the accused to his own purpose, with intent to defraud.
