AT the particular request of many members of the craft this Second Part of the Book of Constitutions is published, and will be delivered to the subacribers separately, that the lodges and brethren may, so much the sooner, possess the Laws and Regulations of the Society. The First Part, containing the History of Masonry, from the earliest period to the end of the year 1815, with Preface and copious Index to the whole work, will be printed with as little delay as possible.

Subscribers are requested not to bind their books till the expiration of three years, when, by a vote of the grand lodge, the laws are to be again revised. Should any alteration or additions be then made, the sheets in which such alterations occur will be re-printed and forwarded to each subscriber.
