

15. They shall have power to appoint among themselves sub-committees or standing committees, for general or special purposes as they may deem expedient.

16. They shall have power to administer generally all the internal affairs of the Club; and to make house rules (not being inconsistent herewith or with any of the By-Laws.)

VACANCIES IN COMMITTEE.

17. In the event of any vacancy occurring in the Committee after the annual general meeting, the committee shall have the power of filling it up.

PENALTY FOR NON-ATTENDANCE.

18. Should any member of the Committee be absent from three consecutive meetings of that body without a satisfactory excuse to the other members, he shall cease to hold office and his place be filled pursuant to Rule 17.

ELECTION OF MEMBERS.

19. Any gentleman wishing to become a member of the Club must be proposed and seconded by two members of the Club in good standing.

20. No member is eligible to use any of the Club boats, or take part in any race or regatta, until he has paid his dues for the current year.
