

I am now through with the 16-h.p. Champion Saw Mill. The engine and machinery are in good condition as when received excepting the usual wear and tear. The mill has given entire satisfaction. and since getting into better timber has gone far beyond my expectations, sawing on an average 15,000 feet of bridge timber of 6x8, 6x12, 9x12, every ten hours.
