SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTHWEST LAND REGULATIONS

A NY person who is sole head of a family or any male over eighteen years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Allerte. homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agen y or Sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions, by father mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties.—Six months' residence upon, and cultivation of the land in each of three years A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father in the rest of the second standing may pre-empt a quarter-section along side of his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre Duties.—Must reside six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may take a purchased homestead in certain districts Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300.00.




