'injurious in its Operation within the said Parish of Fredericton;'

Permission to appoint Substitutes in Fredericton repealed. I. Be it therefore enacted, That so much of the said Act as permits the Appointment of Substitutes, so far as relates to the said Parish of Fredericton, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Persons liable to Statute Labour to work in Percon or pay Money. II. And be it further enacted, That from and after the passing of this Act, all and every Person and Persons liable to do Labour on the Highways, Roads, Streets and Bridges within the said Parish of Fredericton, shall either work in Person, or pay the Sum allowed by Law to be received in lieu thereof, and shall not be permitted to send Substitutes, any Law, Usage or Custom to the contrary notwithstanding.

Limitation.

III. And be it further enacted, that this Act shall continue and be in Force so long as the herein before in Part recited Act, to which this is an Amendment, and no longer.

CAP. IV.

An Act to authorize and empower the Magistrates of the County of Charlotte to sell a certain Piece of Land in the Town of Saint Andrews, and to vest the Proceeds in purchasing another Piece of Land for the Purpose of erecting a County Gaol thereon in said Town.
