Mr. Bedard moved, seconded by Mr. Durocher, to resolve, that an humble address be presented to his Excellency the Governor in Chief, informing his Excellency, that this House has resolved to vote, in the present Session, the sums necessary for paying all the Civil Expences of the Government of this Province, and to be seech that his Excellency will be pleased to order the proper officer to lay before this House, an Estimate of the said Civil Expences.

The House divided upon the question:

Yeas 17 Nays 3

It was accordingly,

RESOLVED, that the faid Address be presented to his Excellency the Governor in Chief.

ORDERED, that Mr. Bedard, Mr. Debartzeb, Mr. Jones of Quebec, Mr. Lee, Mr. Hebert and Mr. Durother, do present the said address to his Excellency the Governor in Chief.

The order of the day for the House to resolve into a Committee of the whole House, on the Bill to amend an Act passed in the 39th year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for the better re: " gulating the weights and measures of this Province;" and on the amendments reported by a Special Committee to the said Bill, being read;
