" feverally, our and each of our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, firm-# ly by these presents, sealed with our Seals, dated at

" The Condition of this Obligation is fuch, that if the above bounden A. B. " Ihall collect and levy all the Rates and Affefiments of the faid Township " of for the prefent year, ending on the first Monday in March " next, fo far as the Law may enable him to do; and thall pay all the money " which he shall so collect and levy, to the Treasurer of the said District on " or before the eighth day of March next, then this Obligation to be void, or " elle to remain in full force and virtue,"

VIII. And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That it shall be the duty of the Clerk of the Peace to draw the faid Bond, and he shall be allowed the fum of five thillings for drawing the fame, to be paid out of the District Treasury.

IX. And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That if any Collector for any Township, or united Townships, shall neglect or refuse to give fuch Bond within one month as aforefaid, it shall and may be lawful for the Justices of the Peace at the next General Quarter Sessions, or the majority of them, to appoint a Collector for the faid Township or united Townships; and in the event of refulal, to appoint another as often as the cale may require; and the faid Collector fo to be appointed by the Juffices as aforefaid, shall give the like Bond that is herein directed to be given by the Collector cholen and nominated at the Town Meeting.

X. And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That each and every Collector shall be allowed out of the Treasury of the District, the sum of one shilling for every mile which he shall travel in going to give a Bond to give fuch bond. the Clerk of the Peace, as a compensation for the trouble and expence of himfelf and foreties.

XI. And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That in addition g. to be al- to the fum of three pounds for every hundred pounds now allowed to the Collector, it shall and may be lawful for the Treasurer of each and every District, to pay to each and every Collector the further fum of two pounds on every hundred pounds which thall be collected and paid by him to the faid Treafurer.

> XII. And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That if at any time it shall happen, that through the neglect or refusal of any person or perfons, appointed under the authority of this Act or otherwife, the Affeliment or Rate of any Township or united Townships, shall not have been collected within the year for which fuch Affeffment or Rate was made, it shall and may be lawful for the Collector for the year enfuing, and he is hereby authorized and required to levy the Rate and Affeffment fo in arrear.

Powers of the officers appoinsed under this AG : Penalties to which they are liable.

XIII. And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That all and every Officer and Officers appointed under and by virtue of this Act, shall be, and they are hereby declared to be vefted with the lame powers, and liable 10

55. to be allowed to the Clerk of the Peace for drawing of the bond.

If collector refuse to give. fuch bond, Quarter Sef- tions to appoint another collector, who shall give the like bond.
