The each fish of Wallows Lake, in California, are described as being blood-red in color, very fat, and weighing about eight pounds, and are preferred, when taken, to salmon. It is said there are only four lakes known in which this fish is found—Payette, in Idaho, a lake in Maine, one in Scotland and Wallows Lake.
