

# Moon's Vagaries.

For the last 50 years the place of the moon in the sky given in the official "Nautical Almanac" has been computed from the lunar tables drawn up by the astronomer, Hansen; but for many years the moon has been "running away" from the tables in apparent defiance of the law of gravitation. This problem of the mysterious acceleration of the moon has been tackled by a number of eminent mathematicians, and one of them, Professor E. W. Brown, an astronomer, educated at Hull College and Cambridge, England, has so far solved the problem as to produce a set of lunar tables which confine the moon's error within very small limits. After this year, therefore. Hansen's tables are to be abandoned so far as the English "Nautical Almanac" is con-
