## MARS AND SATURN ARE

## OGGLING AT THE MOON

Phenomenon Observable Last Night May Be Seen Again Tonight.

Many Londoners observed an interesting phenomenon in the skies last night in the juxtaposition of Mars and Saturn with the moon. The two planets were so close together that they appeared only a few inches apart and only a short distance from the moon presented an excellent opportunity for observing them closely. The phenomenon was forecasted by Prof. Barnard of Yerkes Observatory.

Prof. Barnard, vice-principal of the London Normal School, states that the same phenomenon may be observed tonight, only that the moon will be some 13 degrees removed from the two planets. Last night, owing to the brighter light of the moon the planets did not show very brightly, but they may be readily observed tonight. To the eye they appear as a bright double-star, but separated from one another by only two-thirds of the apparent width of the moon.

Anyone wishing to observe the two planets will be able to find the reality by looking about 13 degrees west of the moon shortly before sunrise.

## A FULL CONFESSION

Express Company Agent To Be Sentenced for Theft.

Port Huron, Mich., Aug. 16.—Edwin A. Wellwood, agent for the Canadian Express Company, who has travelled between Port Huron and Toronto and Detroit during the past three years, is awaiting sentence at the county jail here for stealing packages which were being transported by his company.

Wellwood was arrested at Seneforth Grand Trunk Detective Hoolahan, following the investigation of numerous thefts which have occurred within the last few weeks. He pleaded guilty in the police and circuit courts today, and was remanded for sentence. Wellwood is 29 years of age, and lives at three, Ontario street, and was married and has three children. He has made a full confession.
