Detroit, Nov. 17.—John Oskelowski, 30 years old, an inspector at the Ford Motor Company plant at Highland Park, was found dead in the bathroom of the house at 8111 Portland avenue at 9 a. m. today with a three-inch gash in his scalp, inflicted, police believe, with a chisel or an axe. Officers are without a clue to his assailant, who apparently climbed through a window leading into the room and assaulted Oskelowski while the latter was bathing.

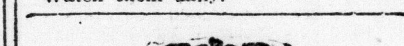

ASSUMES DEBT
FOR EQUIPMENT

St. Thomas Board of Education Will Pay \$56.90 For Collegiate Physical Culture Appliances.

St. Thomas, Nov. 17.—At a meeting of the committees of the board of education this evening it was decided to pay for the physical culture equipment for the collegiate that has been purchased so far this year. The amount for the equipment was \$56.90.

The question was brought up by a deputation from the Athletic Society of the Collegiate Institute of St. Martin, the physical instructor, and J. Turpenney, president of the society.

The deputation asked for \$100 to carry on athletics till the end of the year. The balance of unpaid bills and expenses of the society added to the money spent for equipment totalled \$97, but as the board did not wish to overdraw their year's estimates, it was decided to pay that part of the expenses for which they were directly responsible.

It was decided to move the Fifth house to the rear of the Collegiate, or where the board saw fit, to put a foundation under it, and to use it for school purposes, to relieve accommodation congestion in the collegiate.
