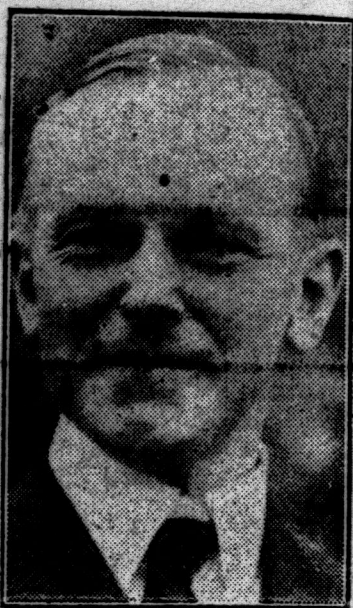


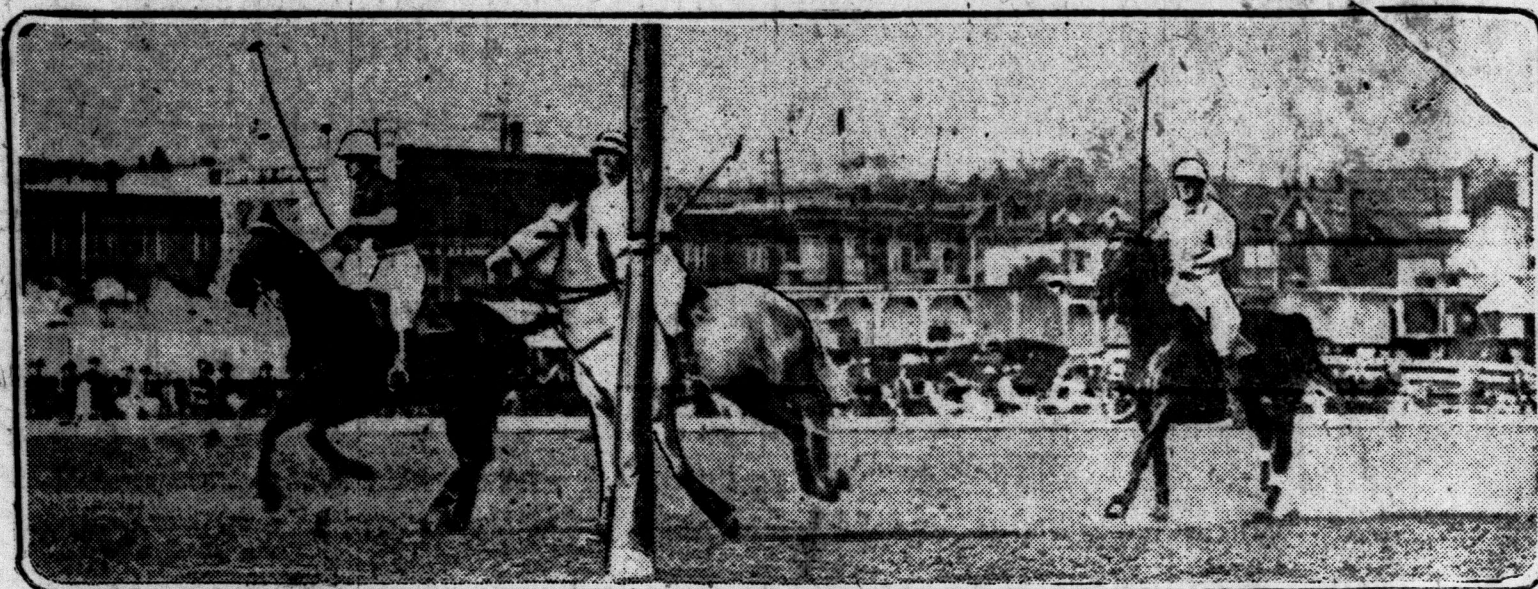

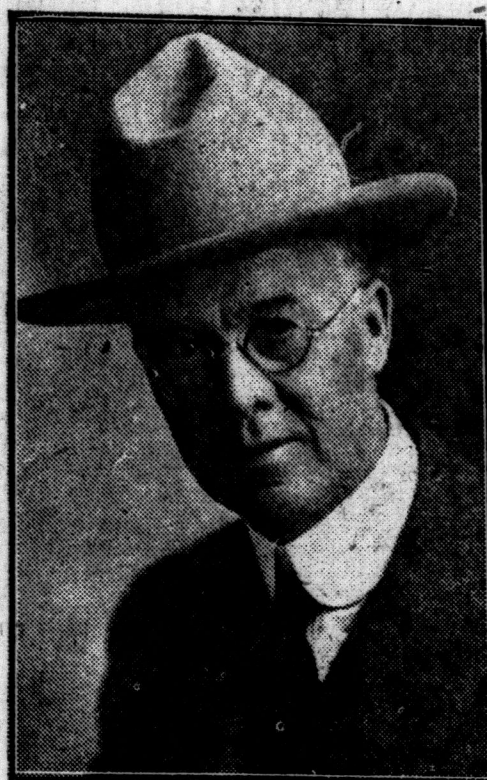

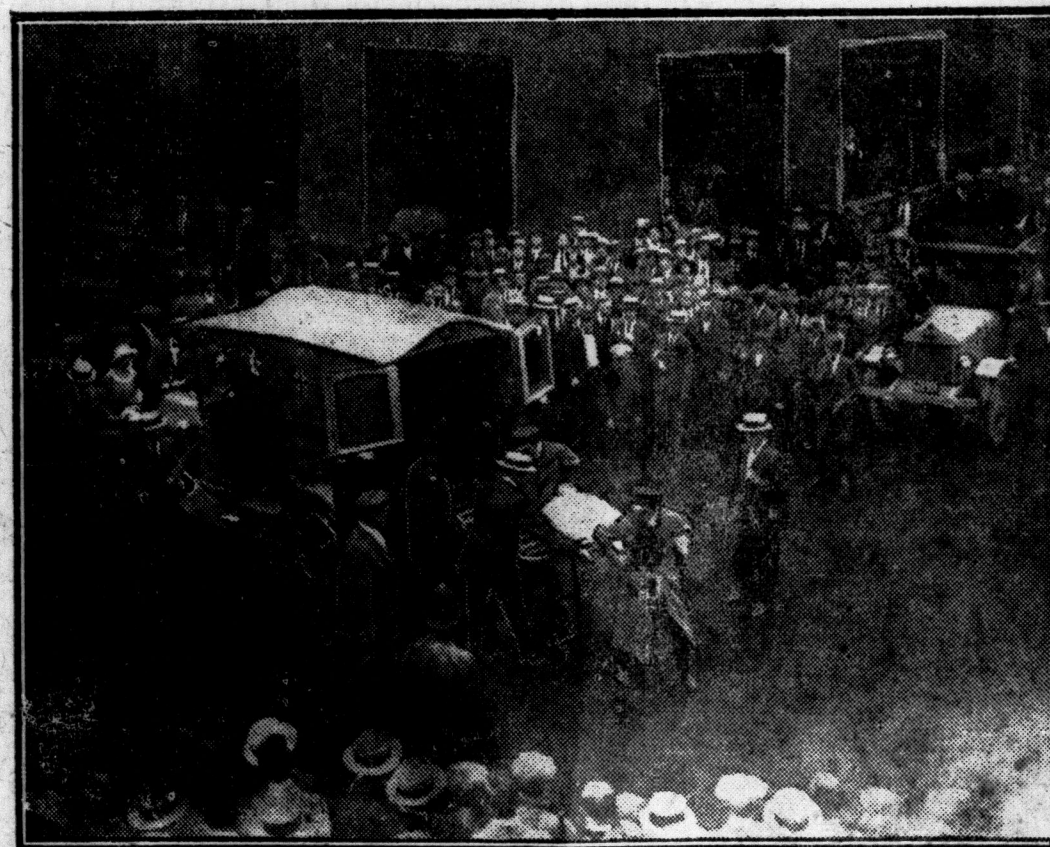
This German howitzer, captured in the war, was diverted from its original purposes when half a dozen Canadian high school teachers made a recreation seat of it during the recent hot spell.



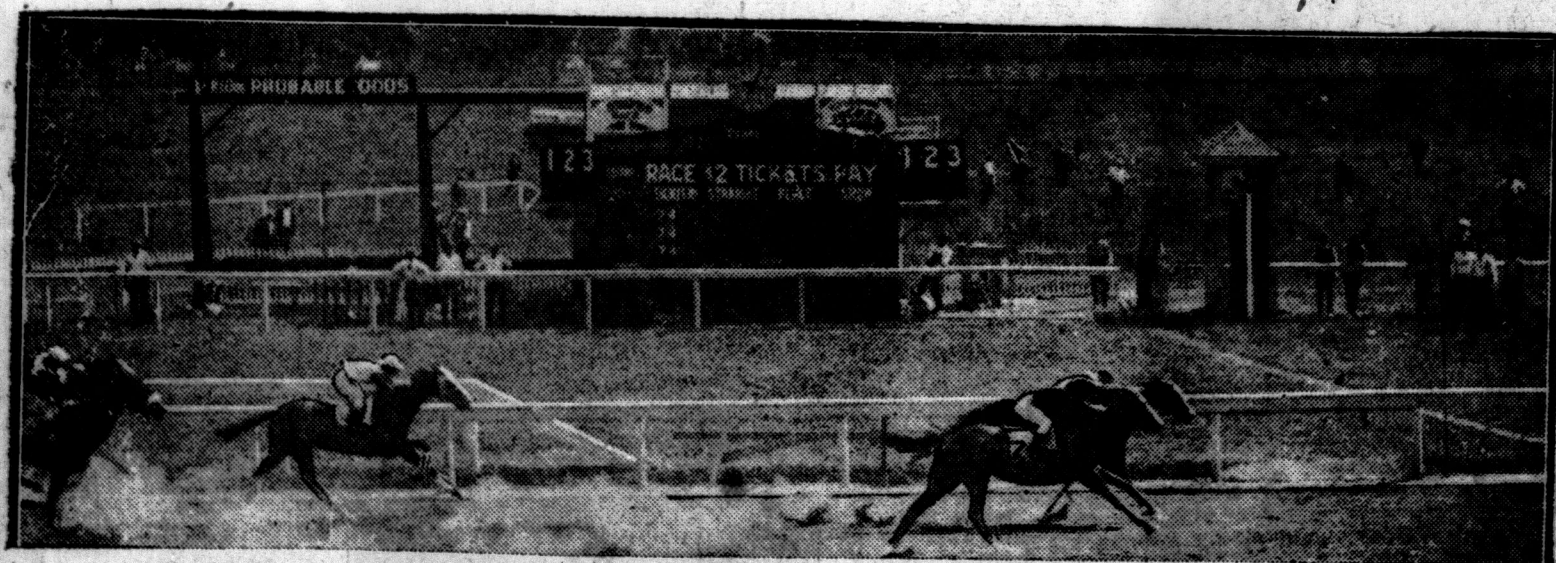
Gene Sarazen, former U. S. open golf champion, is competing in the Canadian open tournament this summer.
