BELLS DOWN TO 78 1-2 CENTS, BUT CLOSING FIRMER.

Provisions Go Higher—New York Stocks Steadier—Better Demand For Local Stocks—Money Easy in New York and First Here—The Live Stock Market—Business Embarrassed.

It is reported that a considerable amount of money is available in Montreal for loaning on C.P.R. stocks. Some of those interested in C.P.R. are looking for an advance in the stock.

Notwithstanding increased immigration into the Northwest Northwest land stock has sold lower than last few days for some months. The decline is due to the tightness of the money market.

May cotton sold down yesterday to 78.82 and closed at 77.91. June closed at 77.73, July at 84.18 and Aug at 84.11.
