tša ká dsi, *adj.*, *fr.* tsáki; moderately good; rather pretty.

tša ká dsi ke, *v. t.*; to make moderately good.

tša ká du i, *v. i.*; improving, becoming good.

tša kák', *interj.*; an expression of contempt or disapprobation.

tša ká ka, *n.*; a bird.

tša ká ka da ka, *n.*; an egg; eggs.

tša ká ka hi, *n.*, *fr.* tsakaka and hi; feathers, any portion of a bird's plumage.

tša ká ka i kǐ si, *n.*; a bird's nest.

tša ke or **tsáki**, modified verbal root; to cause to be divided.

tsá ki, *v. i.*, *adj.*; to be stained with —; to be rendered offensive; suffixed to nouns it forms adjectives; as amatsaki, tsadat-saki, *et al.*

tsá ki or **tsákits** or **sákits**, *adj.*; good; pretty; often accented on last syllable.

tsá ki, *v.*; alone, by itself; used only with pronouns. See *ítsáki*, *mítsáki*, and *šetsáki*.

tša kǐc ti, *adj.*, *fr.* tsáki; very good; very beautiful.—*tsákicti* denotes a still higher degree of excellence than *tsákicti*.

tša kǐ há, *adv.*; quiet, quietly.

tša kǐ há mak, *v. comp.*, *im-* *perative*, *fr.* tsákiha and amak; sit quietly, stay quiet.

tsá ki he, *v.*, *adv.*, *fr.* tsáki; well, in a satisfactory manner; to act well.

tša kǐ ke, *v. t.*, *fr.* tsáki; to improve, to make good, to cure a disease; improved, cured, restored.—*kitsákike* is more frequently employed.

tša kǐs, *n.*; something inferior or worthless, a nuisance.

tša mák, a form of *tsame*, used in the sense of a noun.—*tsamak* *íšiats*, its being hot is bad, *i. e.*, the heat is oppressive.

tša mé [-we], *adj.*; hot, very warm.—*tsawéts*, it is hot.

tša mé a te [-we-], *v. i.*, *fr.* *tsame* and *ate*; to perspire.

tša mé he, *v. t.*; to heat.

tša mé ke, *v. t.*, to make hot, to change from hot to cold; heated.

tša mé kša, *adj.*; constantly warm; very warm.

tša mú tša dǐi [-wu], *adj.*, *fr.* *tsamutsi*; straightish, nearly straight or appearing to be straight.

tša mú tša du i, *v. i.*; straightening.

tša mú tsi [-wu], *adj.*; straight.

tša mú tsi de, *adj.*; almost straight.

tša mú tsi he, *v. t.*; to straighten.

tša mú tsi ke, *v. t.*; to straighten; straightened.

tsá pi, *adj.*; puckered, wrinkled.

tsá ti, *v.*, *adj.*; smoothed; oiled; polished.

tša' ti, verbal root, or *fr.* *tša*; stick, impale.

tsá ti ke, *v. t.*, *fr.* *tsati*; to polish.

tsá tse or **tsátsi** or **sátsi**, *n.*; a species of goshawk or falcon, known on the Upper Missouri as the "spotted eagle".

tša tsú i ta ma pa, *n.*; the pasque-flower or pulsatilla.

tša tsú kǐ, *adj.*, *fr.* *tsuki* and *tsa*; hard to break, not brittle.

tša tsú kǐ ke, *v. t.*; to render hard; hardened.
