4. COAL. A Lecture before the C. P. B. Literary.

5. EDUCATION IN MANITOBA Published by the British Association of Science. A paper given in full in the beautiful Memorial Volume of the late meeting. Printed in Montreal.

6. THE MOUND BUILDERS. Published by the Historical and Scientific Society of Manitola. Dr. Bryps is an active explorer, and a fortunate discovers in the Meunds of the North-West. This gives the result of his personal observations.

7. THE FIVE FORTS OF WINNIPEG. Now being published by the Royal Society of Canada, Description with maps of Forts Rouge, Gibraltar Douglass, Old Fort Garry, and Fort Garry within the limits of the Cuty of Winnipeg.

8. THE LAOCOON OF EVOLUTION. Published by the Brittish and Foreign Frangelinal Review. A crititism of articles by Herbert Spencer and Frederick Harrison, in the Nineteenth Century Magazine, and the account given for a Christian Theism.
