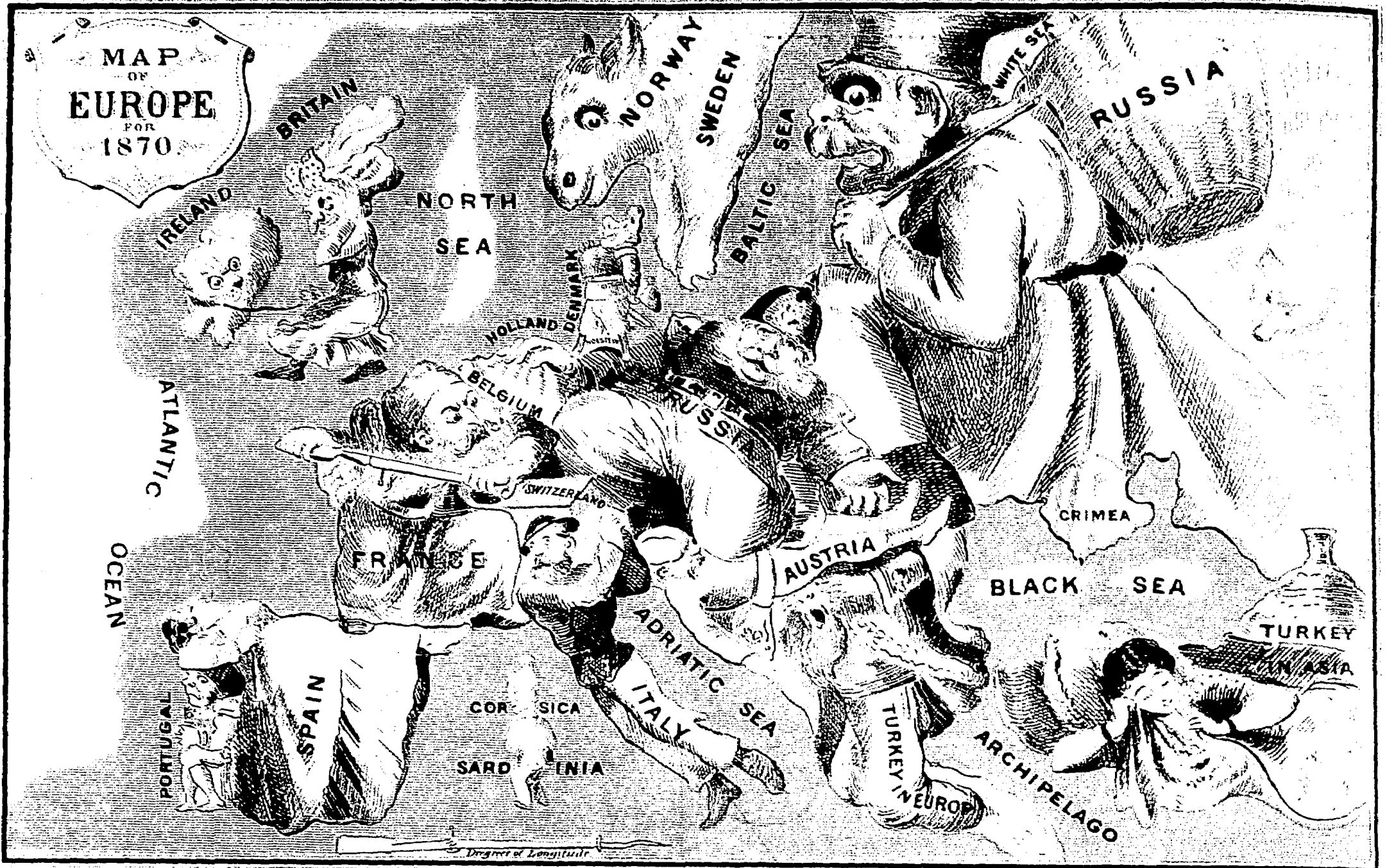


LATEST WAR MAP OF EUROPE.
