There are 10,000 tons of reasonably assured and probable ore, carrying 1.73 per cent. copper and about 20 cents in gold and silver, in the Copper Mountain holdings of the British Columbia Copper Co., a subsidiary of the Canada Copper Corporation, according to Oscar Lachmund, general manager. The ore is a milling product, and the company plans to treat it by flotation.
