⁵ Systems of trade. Imports: under the general system (G), both goods entering directly for domestic consumption and goods entered into customs storage are recorded, at the time of their first arrival, as imports; under the special trade sytem (S), goods are recorded as imports when declared for domestic consumption whether at time of entry or on withdrawal from customs storage. Exports: outward moving goods consist of; (a) national goods, i.e. those wholly or partly produced in the country; (b) foreign goods, neither transformed nor declared for domestic consumption in the country, which move outward from customs storage; (c) nationalized
