To add events to a chart:

- 1. On the toolbar, click the Add Counter button.
- 2. In the Add to Chart dialog box, from the Object drop-down list, select the object you want to chart.
- 3. In the Counter list box, select the desired counter.
- 4. If applicable, in the Instance box, select the desired instance.
- 5. Choose Add.
- 6. If desired, repeat steps 2 through 5 until all desired objects have been added to the chart.
- 7. When finished, choose Done.

To delete events from a chart:

- 1. Select the desired object.
- 2. On the toolbar, click the Delete Selected Counter button.

To view registry information:

- 1. From the Start menu, choose Programs.
- 2. From the Programs submenu, choose Administrative Tools.
- 3. From the Administrative Tools submenu, choose Windows NT Diagnostics.
- 4. If desired, select the tab for the information you want to view.

To print registry information:

- 1. In the Windows NT Diagnostics dialog box, choose Print.
- 2. In the Create Report dialog box, select the desired options.
- 3. Choose OK.
- 4. If you are printing the information to a text file, in the Save WinMSD Report dialog box, select the desired drive and folder, enter the desired file name, and then choose OK.
