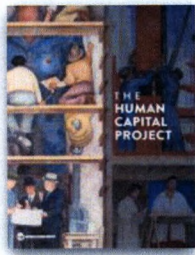
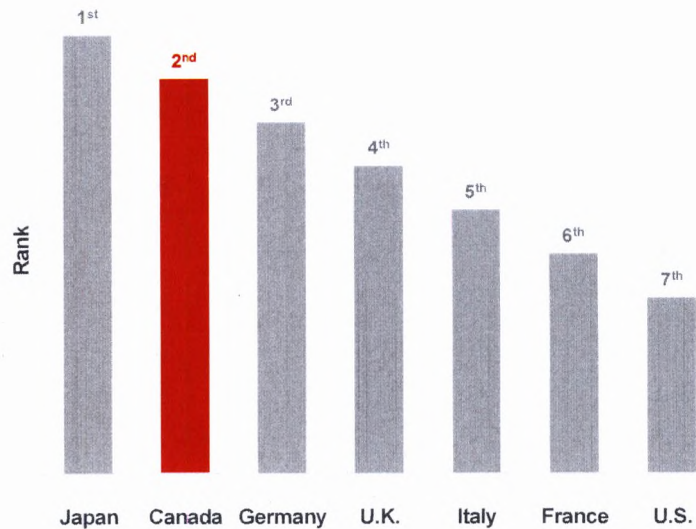


...with high prospects for a productive workforce...

- According to the *Human Capital Index**, Canada ranks second in the G7 and tenth among 157 countries in terms of the degree to which their health and education systems lead to a productive workforce.



Human Capital Index* 2018 G7 Ranking



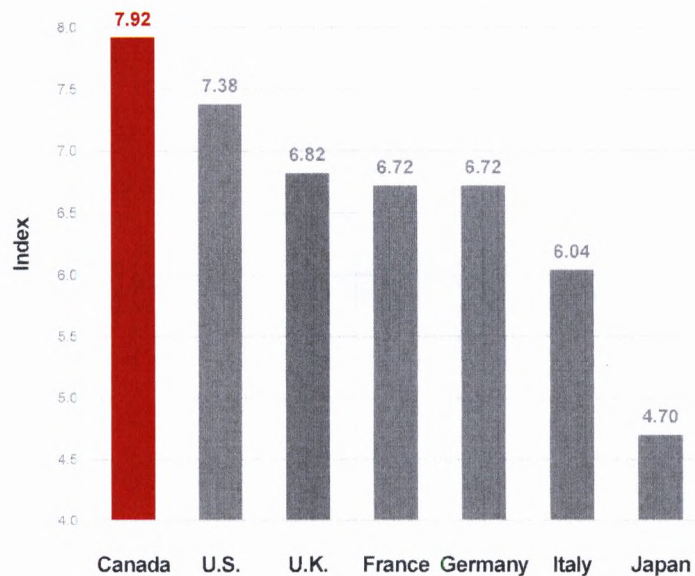
* The Human Capital Index ranks countries based on five indicators: child survival, school enrolment, quality of learning, healthy growth and adult survival.
