

Other matters considered by the Canadian Government included encouragement of responsible investment through programmes currently administered by the Canadian International Development Agency and Export Development Corporation, maintenance of Canada's non-discriminatory immigration policy, resolution of bilateral trading problems, the desire of the area to export more to Canada, the need to improve administration of Canada's substantial development assistance programme for the area, the possibility of closer co-operation in a number of fields, and the means of strengthening co-ordination of policies in Canada.

Senator Martin's report to the Canadian Government is based on his exchanges with the governments in the Commonwealth Caribbean. On December 8 he made a comprehensive statement to the Senate of Canada and this statement provides further background to current Government decisions.
