## SIR THOMAS ROWE'S WELCOME.

ON Thursday, June 10th, 1824, at eight A.M., the Earl of Liverpool steam-vessel took us in tow, and leaving our hulk at Deptford, at three P.M., we anchored at Greenhithe.

June.

On the 11th, Professor Barlow, for whom we had waited at Greenhithe, came on board and fitted his plate for correcting the compasses from the effects of local attraction. On the 12th we weighed, and working down the river, anchored at night in Lee Roads. Weighing at daylight on the 13th, we reached the Little Nore at noon, and found lying there his majesty's surveying-vessel, Snap, Lieut. F. Bullock, who having taken on board a portion of our stores, in consequence of the
