

by the Secretary. And a Register shall be kept in a conspicuous part of the Library-room, of the names of all persons who shall contribute the value of Five Pounds, more than the amount of their original deposit, to the benefit of the Institution.

XXIV.

A Book shall be kept in the Library-room by the Under-Librarian, in which any Subscriber may insert the name (adding his Signature) of any work, which he may wish to recommend to be added to the Library, and the Committee are to decide upon the purchase.

XXV.

Military and Naval Officers visiting the Garrison, and persons not eligible to become Subscribers, may be admitted to the Library-room, when introduced by a Subscriber ; but are not to have Books issued to them.
