TO the President of the Board of Health of the Gore District:

Sir----I have this morning received a communication from Doct. GILPIN of Brantford, stating he was called to visit Three cases, which he considers exhibited characters of Spasmodic Cholera. One case, a man by the name of **Young**, proved fatal in 8 hours. The other two were convalescent when **Doctor** Gilpin writes.

The following is a report I submit to the Board of Health, on the above cases :
