While you have the opportunity, do not miss visiting the Island of Orleans, the most Historical Island in Canada. You will never regret it.

You will see many signs of the early days of the French Regime including the oldest country convent in Canada, four of the oldest churches, Seigneurial Mills, typical French houses, Site of old Huron Fort, etc.

General Wolfe landed on this Island, at St-Laurent, on June 27th, 1759, where he established his headquarters and commenced his campaign for the siege of Quebec.

Wonderful views of Montmorency Falls, Laurentian Mountains, Ste. Anne de Beaupré, Cape Tourmente, St. Lawrence River with its islands also its dominating villages.

The new oil burner Ferry "SS. L'Ile D'Orléans" (SS. Isle of Orleans) with a capacity of 40 cars makes ten round trips daily during the summer season from Champlain Market wharf to Ste. Petronille, I. O.

It will bring you there in twenty minutes.

This trip will also give the tourist the opportunity of seeing QUEBEC and CAPE DIAMOND, from the Beautiful St. Lawrence River.

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
