

Levels Fifth Consecutive Day's Rise---Mining Market on Down Grade

Outlook Favorable For Foreign Crops

But Fine, Warm Weather is Needed in Some Parts of Europe.

Broomhall's weekly summary of foreign crop conditions is as follows: United Kingdom.—The winter wheat crop is doing well. The spring crop is in need of fine, warmer weather. Germany.—The condition of the winter crops is favorable. The sowing of the spring crops is progressing satisfactorily. Supplies of native wheat smaller, but there is fair increased purchases of foreign wheat. A leading firm there confidently predicts continued good imports in the future. Weather reasonable. Russia.—Outlook for wheat already seeded is about normal. Supplies generally moderate. Hungary.—Outlook has shown much improvement during the week. India.—Weather generally favorable and harvesting making satisfactory progress. There are good offerings for forward shipment. Australia.—Flowing and sowing of the new crop is progressing favorably.

EUROPEAN VISIBLE.

The European visible wheat supply this week is \$9,376,000 bushels, against \$1,238,000 bushels last week, a decrease for the week of 1,912,000 bushels.
