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same be unanimously in favor of the applicant, he or she shall thereby be elected; but if one or more black balls appear in either ballot, the applicant shall be rejected; and in no case shall a reconsideration be had, except upon a voluntary motion of all those who cast black balls; and never more than one motion for a reconsideration in the same case shall be allowed. A favorable balloting can be reconsidered at any meeting prior to the admission of the candidate, provided, a majority of the members present agree thereto.

Sec. 3. This Lodge shall confer the Degree of Rebekah only on such persons who apply for and are duly elected to membership therein.

Sec. 4. Candidates rejected in this Lodge may renew their application for membership therein at the expiration of six months after such rejection.

Sec. 5. An Official Certificate may be used to accompany a petition for membership by a member of a Lodge in another jurisdiction.
