same be unanimously in favor of the applicant, he or she shall thereby be elected; but if one or more black balls appear in either ballot, the applicant shall be rejected; and in no case shall a reconsideration be had, except upon a voluntary motion of all those who cast black balls; and never more than one motion for a reconsideration in the same case shall be allowed. A favorable balloting can be reconsidered at any meeting prior to the admission of the candidate, provided, a majority of the members present agree thereto.

- Sec. 3. This Lodge shall confer the Degree of Rebekah only on such persons who apply for and are duly elected to membership therein.
- Sec. 4. Candidates rejected in this Lodge may renew their application for membership therein at the expiration of six months after such rejection.
- Sec. 5. An Official Certificate may be used to accompany a petition for membership by a member of a Lodge in another jurisdiction.
